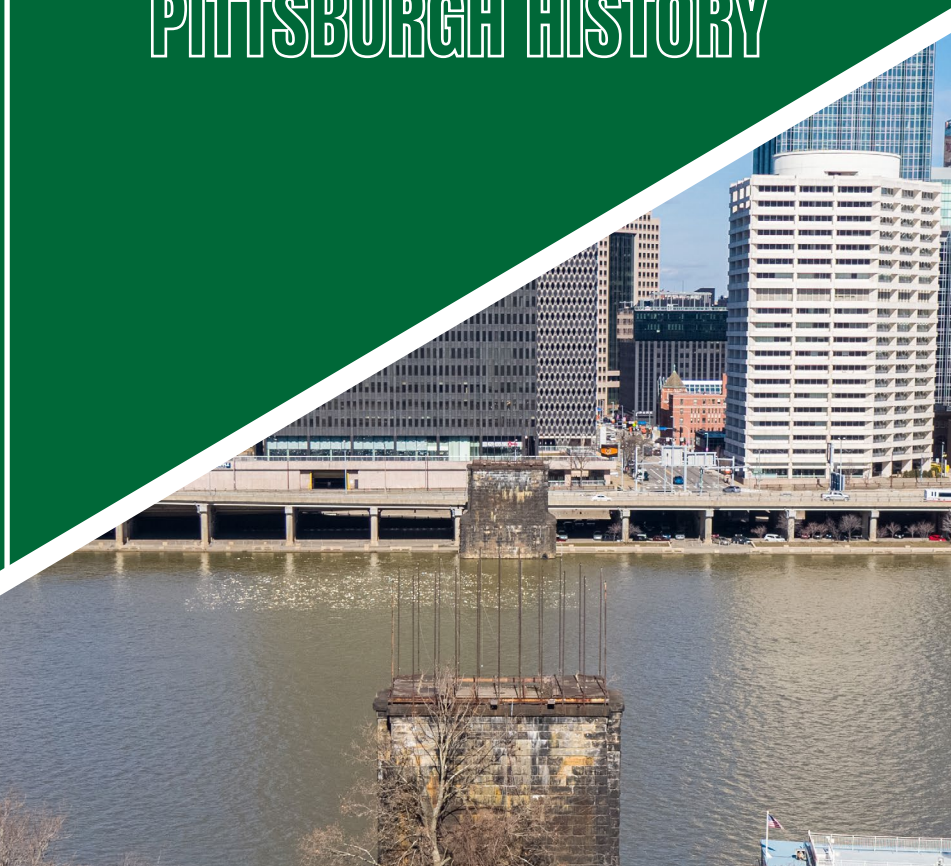

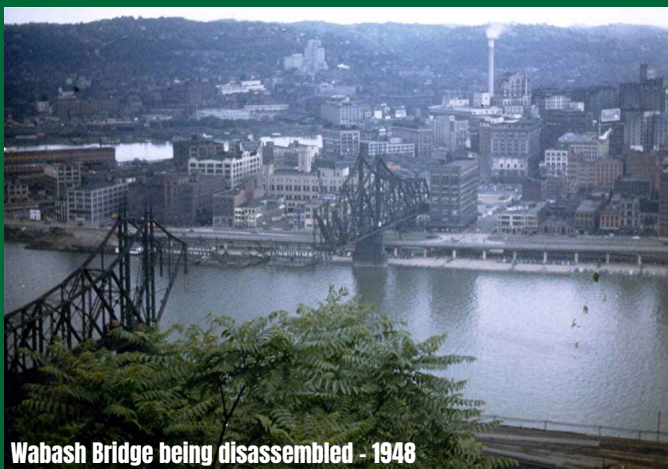
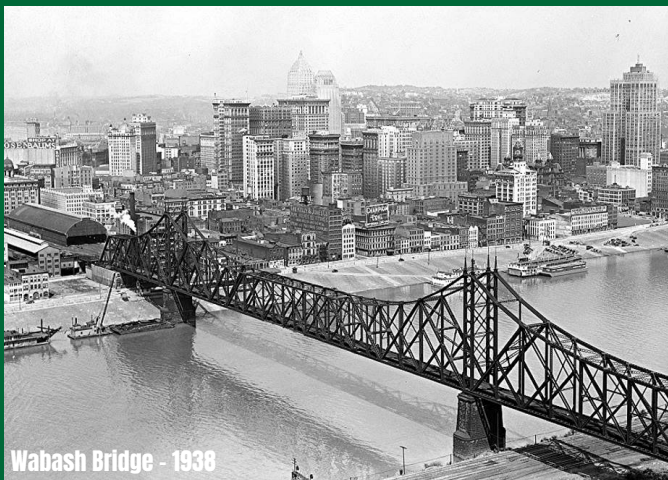


AN OPPORTUNITY UNLIKE ANY OTHER IN THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH.

The Wabash Bridge was completed in 1904 - at that time, it was the longest railroad bridge in the country and third longest in the world. It connected the Wabash Tunnels on the south shore of the Monongahela River to the railroad terminal complex on Liberty Avenue in Downtown Pittsburgh. After the Wabash Terminal was destroyed by a fire in 1946, the Bridge was dismantled in 1948.

The bridge piers, one to the north near the Mon Wharf and one to the south adjacent to Station Square, are for sale. The potential uses range from advertising, marina, restaurant, rock climbing, and even a zip line!
